THE #ERASMUSDAYS, THE OFFICIAL EUROPEAN CELEBRATION

A new European Celebration of Education and Citizenship, the #ErasmusDays have brought together 39 countries with more than 1,435 events. The quick development of this European festival (now in its second year) reflects the desire to celebrate locally the useful and concrete benefits of Europe, together with citizens and stakeholders of European projects.



Under the high patronage of the President of the European Parliament, Mr Antonio Tajani, and the European Commission, the #ErasmusDays have demonstrated the vitality of the European idea.

More than **116 million people** experienced these #ErasmusDays through media and social networks. Pupils, students, apprentices, job seekers, teachers, trainers, actors from the associations sector, parents and former Erasmus... They testified about their experience of mobility and cooperation in Europe and around the world to promote the opportunities funded by the European Union and the impact of the projects they support.

The #ErasmusDays were an opportunity:

- to concretely illustrate the **European projects** thanks to the actors and beneficiaries of Erasmus+ and give the floor to the **European citizens**;
- to **mobilise the different territories** and all local actors (public and private institutions, companies, communities, associations, decision-makers, media);
- to unite countries in Europe and in the rest of the world around the Erasmus brand, which is the
 third achievement at the European Union level (according to the mid-term evaluation of Erasmus+
 by the European Commission in January 2018);
- to label several debates at the heart of the Citizen Conventions;
- to register several of these events as part of the European Year of Cultural Heritage.

The list of countries participating in the #ErasmusDays shows that Erasmus+ is open to the world: Albania, Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cameroon, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Finland, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM), France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Ivory Coast, Kosovo, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Morocco, Niger, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, United Kingdom, Senegal, Serbia, Slovenia, Spain, South Africa, Sweden, Turkey.





A few months before the **European elections** and in the middle of the #ThisTimeImVoting campaign, the #ErasmusDays have widely mobilised.

This European celebration brought together stakeholders from professional, association, media, institutional and political circles around more than **1,435 events**. Erasmus+ projects developers organised a wide variety of events to popularise the Erasmus+ projects: interviews with European and international affairs and research departments within universities; meetings with European project partners; photo exhibitions and contests, concerts, escape games, theatrical performances, food tastings, radio broadcasts, Erasmus+ inaugurations and plaque presentations, citizen consultations, sports events, treasure hunts, open houses, etc. All these activities made it possible to reach all audiences in all sectors.

The #ErasmusDays took place on campuses, in schools, in the heart of cities and centres for young people and learning. Some spaces opened their doors especially; all brought their audiences together around international mobility (study, internship, training, civic service, sports activities, etc.). Parents of students and families were also involved on the weekend.

THE EUROPEAN YEAR OF CULTURAL HERITAGE

As 2018 is the European Year of Cultural Heritage, educational institutions working in the cultural sector have promoted their Erasmus+ projects.





115 #ErasmusDays events have been labelled European Year of Cultural Heritage.

An international event was held at the Acropolis Museum in **Athens**, in partnership with the Greek, Italian and French Ministries of Culture, as well as the Greek Ministry of Education and the French Embassy in Greece.




Number of likes, comments and retweets












AUSTRIA

Junos suchen eine Allianz mit Macron

Die NEOS-Jugend kooperiert mit der Jugendfraktion des französischen Präsidenten. Hintergrund ist die Suche nach neuen Partnern im EU-Parlament.

Wien - Im Mai 2019 findet die EU-Wahl statt. Noch beschränkt sich der heimische Wahlkampf auf die chaoti-sche Suche der SPÖ nach einem Spitzenkandidaten, Auf höherer Ebene wird im Hintergrund bereits an Bündnissen gearbeitet. Die Junos – die Jugendorganisation der NEOS wollen bei diesem Prozess eine treibende Kraft sein.

Zum heutigen <u>Erasmus</u>-Tag startet eine gemeinsame Aktion der Junos mit derzeit etwa 14 weiteren liberalen Ju-gendorganisationen in Europa. Grenzüberschreitend wird ein 12 Punkte umfassender Fragebogen ausgerollt, mit dem man die grundsätzliche Haltung von Bürgern zu Europa erfahren wird. "Meines Wissens ist das die größte europaweite Befragung, die von so vielen Organisationen unterstützt wurde", sagt Jurios-Chef Douglas Hoyos. Darauf ist der Nationalratsabgeordnete "extrem stolz". In allen Bundesländern

will man auf Menschen zuge hen und mit ihnen "über ihre Vorstellungen, ihre Wünsche, ihre Kritik und ihre Visionen für die Europäische Union reden". Das Ziel, so Hoyos, sei es, "weit über 1000" Interessierte zu befragen und da-mit eine repräsentative Stich-probe zu liefern. Denn: "Für uns junge Europäer reicht es nicht, nur planlos Kritik zu üben und nationalkonserva-

tive Töne anzuschlagen," Die Kooperation soll außerdem "Startschuss für etwas Größeres" (Hovos) sein.

So wird diese Zusammenarbeit der Jugendorganisationen der liberalen ALDE (Allianz der Liberalen und Demokraten) mit den "Jeunes avec Ma-cron", der Jugendfraktion des französischen Präsidenten Emmanuel Macron, als "starkes Signal für die Bildung einer Allianz" gesehen. Die Positionierung von Macrons Bewe-gung ist derzeit offen, eine Teilnahme bei ALDE scheint jedenfalls genau so plausibel wie die Gründung einer neuen pro-europäischen Bewegung Junos-Vorsitzender Hoyos sieht als größte Gemeinsamsieht als größte Geniensam-keit zwischen ALDE und der Macron-Gruppe "den Kampf für eine liberale Demokratie und gegen die Straches und Orbáns". Für ihn ist die Europawahl nichts weniger als "eine Schicksalswahl zwischen jenen, die das gemeinsame Europa zerstören wollen und jenen liberalen Kräften, die für ein starkes, handlungsfähiges und geeintes Europa kämpfen*.

Derzeit gibt es im Europäi-schen Parlament acht Frakti-onen – von Pro-Europäern bis Gegnern - sowie fraktionslose Abgeordnete. Wer künftig zusammenarbeite, sei wichtig. heißt es im österreichischen Verbindungsbüro des EU-Parlaments. Ob es mehr Europa weniger oder sogar Stillstand gebe, hängt auch davon ab.





BELGIUM








BULGARIA

In Shumen, children from several nursery schools sang, danced, told, drew and presented their Erasmus+ projects in front of the Vasil Drumev Theatre.










CROATIA

The national agency organised a training course for leaders in the sector of youth to enable them to implement human rights education activities in their day-to-day work. This beginner-level training helped participants to develop their basic skills (knowledge, skills, attitudes) necessary for the implementation of human rights education activities.

The Agency for Mobility and EU Programmes proposed an Inspiration Day which was conceived as an inspirational conference, where experienced beneficiaries delivered TED-like talks with the aim of motivating and inspiring new and potential applicants to submit Erasmus+ project proposals in the field of Vocational Education and Training. The presentations were delivered by beneficiaries, specifically chosen for their inspirational stories with experience in implementation of projects in the field of Vocational Education and Training (Key Actions 1 and 2).



A segment about Inspiration Day was aired on the Croatian national television in the morning show called *Dobro jutro Hrvatska* (Good morning Croatia) and featured the organizers, one of the speakers/beneficiaries and prominently featured Erasmus Days in talking points and visually.





The University of Helsinki took part in the digital exhibition EPALE with its project HANDMADE WELLBEING.




This project was aimed at developing the professional skills of artistic and hand-craft leaders and improve workshop practices relating to the care of the elderly.

A FEW REMARKABLE EVENTS

The **University of Paris-Saclay** organised an information day and workshops on Erasmus+ opportunities for teacher-researchers.

The Occitanie **Pôle emploi** (Employment centre) agencies in **Toulouse** organised workshops to learn about the benefits of professional experience abroad and how to apply to "go on an Erasmus" with Pôle emploi. In Bordeaux, the regional management of Pôle emploi offered a day of discussion and testimonials at the **Bordeaux** Aquitaine National Theatre (TNBA) on the theme: "Move abroad, an opportunity for culture professionals." On **Réunion** Island, the Pôle emploi agency in Saint-Pierre provided information to promote Erasmus mobility experiences.

In Bordeaux, the **Urban Vibrations School** association opened a Europe information point in the priority neighbourhood of Aubiers. On the 12th and 13th of October, their European village offered activities, intergenerational cooking workshops, a concert, as well as a debate on employment and integration.

The Hauts-de-France Canopy Network presented a seminar on Erasmus+ school exchanges in Lille on the 12th of October, with the participation of the DAREIC services of Academy of Lille, of the **National eTwinning Office**.

The German Erasmus+ Vocational Training Agency (BIBB) organised a day of information and feedback on EuroApprentices at the Federal Ministry of Education in Bonn.

IHK-Projektgesellschaft mbH organised a mobility day with the partners of vocational education and training (OSZ), the Europe Direct Information Centre (EDIC) and the Chamber of Trades (HWK). The various intercultural workshops were aimed at reducing the inhibitions of German and Polish apprentices. The day ended with a cruise on the Oder River that connects the two countries.









ErasmusDays - Rückblick 2018

Am 12. und 13 Oktober fanden die ErasmusDays europaweit zum zweiten Mal statt und konnten mit über 1435 Projekten in 39 Ländern einen deutlichen Erfolg verbuchen. 2017 von der Nationalen Agentur in Frankreich ins Leben gerufen, hatte die Kampagne bereits letztes Jahr einen beachtlichen Zulauf - in Deutschland allerdings war die Resonanz noch nicht so stark ausgeprägt wie in diesem Jahr!

Proud to be European: Die Bemühungen, in diesem Jahr mit einem einheitlichen Erscheinungsbild und der Verknüpfung mit inhaltlich passenden anderen europäischen Initiativen die Bekanntheit der ErasmusDays zu steigern, waren erfolgreich. So wurde beispielsweise das europäische Jahr des kulturellen Erbes und die Kampagne EUandME zur Verbreitung genutzt.

Nicht zuletzt durch die Schirmherrschaft des Europäischen Parlaments und der Europäischen Kommission konnte die Sichtbarkeit der ErasmusDays deutlich erhöht werden. Mit dem Leitspruch "Proud to be European" und dem Hinweis an alle EU-Abgeordneten, mit diesem während der ErasmusDays Werbung für die Europawahl zu machen, haben die Nationalen Agenturen und ihre Projekte ein deutliches Zeichen für Europa gesetzt, welches erfreulicherweise besonders in Ländern wie Ungarn und der Türkei auf extrem fruchtbaren Boden gefallen ist.



The Intercultural Education Secondary School in Evomos presented an exhibition and a geocaching route on the theme "a healthy lifestyle is a sustainable lifestyle".










HUNGARY

The National Agency worked with the Embassy of France with the support of the Representation of the European Commission in Ireland and the embassies of Belgium, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Spain and Switzerland to present the exhibition "European Union[s]," introducing 17 Franco-European families.


Some examples:

11 EVENTS OUTSIDE EUROPE AND IN AFRICA

The Campus France in **Georgia** has created a communication campaign and a series of testimonials to promote Erasmus +.

In Africa, six events were organised. They highlight the actions of the Erasmus+ programme for Europe-Africa cooperation in education and training, in South Africa, Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, Morocco, Niger and Senegal.



In Pretoria, **South Africa**, the Embassy of France and the Alliance Française organised an event on Erasmus+ partnership opportunities between Africa and Europe, based on the example of the project *Black Women in Science: the cultural and societal impacts of the Erasmus+ programme*.



In **Dakar**, the National School of Informatics for Industry and Enterprise (ENSIIE) and the Polytechnic School (ESP) invited more than 300 students on Saturday October 13th to a great celebration in front of the African Renaissance Monument with a Johno Band concert, a balloon release, movies and testimonies from Erasmus alumni, and meetings with local companies.

In **Morocco**, the University of Murcia (Marrakech campus) organised the close-out meeting of its Erasmus+ project on ICTs applicable to scientific experimentation.





In Abidjan in **Côte d'Ivoire**, Nangui Abrogoua University organised a full-day conference on the theme of international mobility and opportunities under the Erasmus+ program, with testimonials from staff and student beneficiaries.

In **Cameroon**, at the National Polytechnic School of Yaoundé, Cameroon's Minister of Higher Education participated in a round-table discussion on Africa-Europe cooperation for the benefit of training engineers in Cameroon.

In **Niger**, the French Embassy in Niamey organised a conference at Abou Moumouni University on Friday October 12th with representatives of the European Union, the Rectoral Team and the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation.



The Balkan countries have also been taking part, with events in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, and Kosovo.



Albania presented the AL-Tour project which aims at supporting quality and access to tourism education and training in order to improve the quality of services and the impact of this sector.

The University of **Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina)** arranged a scholarship fair bringing together the various institutions offering scholarships (governmental and non-governmental organisations, embassies, civil initiative centres, local communities, foreign institutions, cultural centres, universities, etc.)

The University of **Pristina (Kosovo)**, in collaboration with the Erasmus+ office, proposed a one-day seminar on the principles of academic freedom and ethics at the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology. This seminar focused on academic freedom and the challenges of its implementation from a regional and global perspective, and addressed ethical principles in higher education.

The **Moldova** Info Centre and the "MilleniuM" Training and Development Institute organised Non-Formal Education Days #ZEN_Moldova. Interested people were invited to discover social games and cinema as non-formal educational tools.
